ACT Human Rights Film Festival at Colorado State University is seeking a **Graphic Design Intern** for Spring 2026. This position offers hands-on experience applying the festival's creative assets across a variety of print and digital platforms while supporting one of the nation's leading human rights-focused film festivals.

Position Overview

The Graphic Design Intern will adapt the festival's 2026 creative designs into a wide range of promotional and communication materials. This role is ideal for a motivated graphic design student interested in marketing and design experience in the nonprofit arts sector.

Key Responsibilities

- Adapt 2026 festival branding and creative assets across multiple formats (print, web, social media, email, signage, and merchandise).
- Prepare design files for digital distribution and professional printing.
- Collaborate with staff to ensure consistent visual identity across platforms.
- Assist with timely delivery of promotional materials leading up to and during the festival.
- Meet tight deadlines with accuracy and ability to work independently.

Qualifications

- Current college student (Spring 2026 enrollment required) in good standing.
- Required: majoring in Art and Art History with a concentration on graphic design.
- Strong attention to detail and ability to follow brand guidelines.
- Ability to juggle multiple projects on tight deadlines.
- Interest in film, human rights, and/or the arts a plus.

- Credit: 3 academic credits in ART 487 (must be arranged with Art & Art History). No additional compensation. Must meet qualifications for internship (enrolled in ART 300 or 400 level classes).
- Location: Colorado State University and remote.

- Applicants may apply for both of ACT's designated internships for AAH majors. Only one internship per person.
