3 Credit Internship Opportunity in Art – for CSU Students

ACT Human Rights Film Festival at Colorado State University is seeking a graphic design student to be our **Exhibition Intern** for Spring 2026. This position centers on bringing the poster art exhibition to life at The Lyric in April 2026, where student-designed posters will be presented both in-person and onscreen.

Position Overview

The Graphic Design Exhibition Intern will play a key role in actualizing the 2026 exhibition, working at the intersection of design and arts presentation. This opportunity provides hands-on experience in preparing work for public display and collaborating with a professional arts venue.

Key Responsibilities

- Organize and prepare student poster submissions for both physical and digital presentation.
- Assist with layout, formatting, and consistency to ensure a polished final exhibition.
- Work with The Lyric's staff and festival team on installation logistics and technical needs.
- Determine any supplies that need purchased for exhibition; assist with sourcing supplies.
- Lead exhibition install and help coordinate timelines, checklists, and materials for a smooth setup.
- Support exhibition promotion and documentation.
- Support planning for exhibition opening and communication with all student artists.

Qualifications

- Current college student (Spring 2026 enrollment required).
- Majoring in Art and Art History and enrolled in 300 or 400 level classes.
 - Preference: concentration in graphic design.
- Strong attention to detail and ability to juggle multiple projects on tight deadlines.
- Interest in film, human rights, and/or the social impact arts a plus.
- Bonus: prior experience with exhibitions, galleries, or art installations.

- Extra bonus: previous events and arts management experience in a professional setting.

- Internship term: Spring 2026 semester.
- Credit: 3 academic credits in ART 487 (must be arranged with Art & Art History). No additional compensation. Must meet qualifications for internship (enrolled in ART 300 or 400 level classes).
- Location: Colorado State University and The Lyric, Fort Collins.
